



# Join us at the annual Davis/Weber UTCH Living History/Geography Museum!

## Activity:

Students will choose a figure from history to study (or a cultural figure from a geographical area). Each student will create a free-standing display board and arrive on April 7th prepared to bring that individual to life by dressing as the figure and answering questions from question cards the student has created. Participants should also invite family and friends to attend the live interactive museum!



## Date and Time:

Tuesday, April 7, 2024 from 5:45 p.m. – 7:45 p.m.

Participants should arrive by 5:45 p.m. to help set up tables and displays

6-6:20 Students interview each other and look at one another's boards

6:20-7:30 Official museum time. Students are expected to be at their stations with their boards to answer questions about their characters. Please explain to your participating students that there is to be no running around or viewing other students boards during this time

7:30-7:45 Clean up and put away tables. Please take any left over food items or props home with you

### **Grade Levels:**

2nd through 12th (2nd grade is a suggestion. Parents may decide to enter younger children.)

### **Registration:**

Students must **register to participate no later than Friday, April 3rd, 2026.**

We will not be having a refreshment table this year, however if you would like to bring a small themed snack pertaining to your character you may. This is not a requirement and if you bring a food item it will be staying at your station - to be handed out during presenting. ### **Requirements:**

1. A formal written report is not required but is encouraged, especially for students in grades 5 to 12.
2. A freestanding display board for a visual aid is required.
3. Because this is a "Living History Museum" we ask that students come dressed in character to the presentation.
4. Please be prepared to introduce your character with a short description/monologue and answer questions about the person/area you are representing. The student should prepare approximately 10 question cards that "museum goers" can select from, and read to the student, who will then answer the question.
5. The following elements should be a part of the oral presentation and can be included in the written report, if the student chooses to complete one:
  - Name of the historical figure; dates he/she lived; place he/she lived.
  - What was this person known for?
  - What was this person's contribution to society and was he/she recognized during his/her own lifetime?
  - How has this person's contribution impacted today's culture or society?
6. Display board should include but is not limited to:
  - A timeline, not only of the historical person but also of the events happening at that time.
  - Pictures, either drawn or copied.
  - Any relevant information that you feel the audience would like to know about this person.
  - A bibliography of at least 3 books that you found helpful in researching this person.

### **Notes:**

- Families and/or friends may choose to work together, and study/present related characters.
- During presenting time (6:20-7:30) students are expected to stay at their stations and present their character, even if that means there is some downtime between museum attendees.
- If participating, please plan to help set up and tear down/clean up
- Please take ALL items that you brought with you when you leave (including themed snacks/props)
